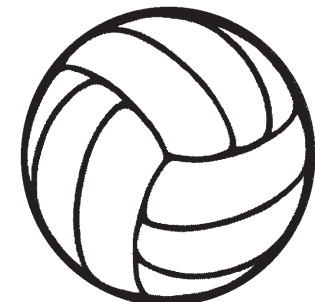

Molly Mordaunt Head Coach



Molly Mordaunt enters her second season as head volleyball coach of the Delta Mustangs. She took over for Michaela Reyes as an assistant coach for three years and as associate head coach in 2010. After playing volleyball at the University of the Pacific for four years, she immediately began her coaching career. Her first coaching job was at powerhouse St. Mary's High School, leading her freshman squad to an undefeated league title. She then moved on as the varsity girls volleyball coach at her alma mater, Lincoln High School where her team placed first in the league during the 2005 season. Molly was the assistant coach at Delta during the 2006 season where she helped lead the Mustangs to a fifth place finish at the State Tournament. From 2007-2008 she was an assistant coach at the University of the Pacific. In returning to Delta for the 2009 season, she again helped guide the Lady Mustangs to another California State Championship appearance. Molly continues to be active in the local scene, coaching teams for Delta Valley Volleyball Club. As a player, Mordaunt helped Lincoln High School claim back-to-back Sac-Joaquin Section and Northern California Regional Division I championships in 1998 and 1999. At Pacific, Mordaunt appeared in three consecutive NCAA Tournaments. Along with her experiences in coaching and running youth volleyball camps, Molly brings an intense love of the game and a passion to teach young athletes the fundamentals of the game. Molly is excited to have an impact on the college level as a head coach.

Michaela Reyes Program Director



Michaela was the head volleyball coach for the Delta Lady Mustangs for five years from 2006 - 2010. As a first year coach, she enjoyed a high level of success after guiding the Lady Mustangs to another Big 8 Conference Championship. They entered the State Volleyball Tournament as the number one seed, having won all of their games up to the state tournament. They were ranked #1 in Northern California after beating all of the top teams in the north and winning all of the tournaments they participated in, including the prestigious San Diego Mesa Invitational. She was named Coach of the Year for the Big 7 Conference and later named Coach of the Year for Northern California.

In her first four seasons, Coach Reyes enjoyed the competition of the tough Big 8 Conference. All five of her teams have advanced to the Northern California Volleyball Championships. All four years her teams won the first round of the Northern California Volleyball Championships. Three teams advanced to the Elite 8, California Community College State Championships. Two of her players achieved All American status. As a result of a strong academic emphasis in her program, her athletes have a high transfer and graduation rate and numerous players have earned scholarships.

Before coming to Delta, Michaela enjoyed a high level of success at her previous stops. She coached high school volleyball at St. Mary's High School in Stockton for the 2004 and 2005 seasons where her teams were undefeated in their conference play. She also enjoyed success at the club level both in Stockton and in San Diego. She spent two years officiating college men's and women's volleyball in the San Diego area.

Michaela played Division I volleyball at San Diego State University 4 years including one in which her team qualified for the sweet 16 of the NCAA tournament. While at San Diego State, she was involved in developmental clinics with the San Diego youth in the off season. In 2004, Michaela moved back to Stockton to take a teaching position at St. Mary's High School, and she coached the Sophomore volleyball team. The two seasons she coached at St. Mary's, her sophomores were undefeated in their conference.

Along with the many successes her teams have enjoyed at Delta College she ran youth clinics for 5 years enhancing area volleyball players skills.
